# Wheelchair and Disabled Friendly Weston



**A guide for mobility hire,  
walks, toilets and

## Wheelchair Friendly Attractions

### The Grand Pier

The Grand Pier is completely accessible with lifts and escalators to all floors. There are accessible toilets on the premises with step-free access. The doors are wide enough for a manual wheelchair and mobility scooters. In their disabled toilets there are grab rails, raised toilet seats and easy turn taps. No RADAR key is needed.

### Weston SeaQuarium

The SeaQuarium is accessible to wheelchair and mobility users. All staff are trained in disability awareness. The gift shop can be accessed fully by wheelchair users and help is willingly given to reach goods on shelves. All doors are usually left open unless it is poor weather and full staff assistance is offered to all customers who may require it. There is a wheelchair unisex toilet and no RADAR key is needed.

### Weston Museum

Weston Museum has a lift to access the main upper floor galleries. Due to the nature of Clara's Cottage being built in 1865, this part is not accessible to wheelchair users due to narrow corridors and staircase. The courtyard area of the museum is cobbled and the museum offers rubber matting to make wheelchairs easier to push. Clara's Café is hard floored and accessible.

## Wheelchair Friendly Attractions

### Weston Sand Sculpture Festival

At the Sand Sculpture Festival there's a wooden slatted path that runs over the beach around the sand sculptures and a willing team is on hand if you require assistance.

### The Land Train

The Land Train has wheelchair access. It runs from the Visitor Information Centre at the Tropicana to the Grand Pier and then to the entrance of Knightstone Island. It runs regularly in the high season and operates on fair weather days and weekends in low seasons. The train does not have a timetable.

### Puxton Park

The grounds at Puxton Park are suitable for wheelchair and disabled users. There are several disabled toilets on site. There also designated disabled parking spaces to the main entrance on concrete and from all the other areas on tarmac or hardcore.

### Weston Helicopter Museum

The Helicopter Museum is a mobility friendly attraction with wheelchair access to all areas.

### Court Farm

Court Farm is wheelchair friendly with accessible toilets.

## Need to hire a wheelchair or mobility scooter?

**You can hire these from Dalesway Mobility Centre at the bottom of Carlton Street Car Park.**

### Directions:

- From the Visitor Information Centre walk northwards towards the Sky Wheel.
- Cross over at the pedestrian crossing opposite the Premier Inn and walk straight down onto Carlton Street.
- On the right hand side of the road you will see Carlton Street Car Park and Dalesway Mobility Centre.

You can hire wheelchairs and mobility scooters daily or weekly and if you're staying in a hotel or B&B in Weston-super-Mare Dalesway will deliver and collect free of charge.
